## *Tour of Historic Markers*

<b>1. Reuben Wilson Landing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is located on the north side of N.Y. Route 18 East Lake Road, near the Maple Road.</li></ul>	<b>2. Port of Entry</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on a large stone at the entrance to the Wilson Boathouse Restaurant at 57 Harbor Street</li></ul>
<b>3. Wilson Collegiate Institute</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker stands in front of the Town Hall at 375 Lake Street.</li></ul>	<b>4. Tabor Bridge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker stands next to the bridge just south of Young St. on N.Y. Route 425 (Lake Street)</li></ul>
<b>5. Anchor Farm</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on the east side of N.Y. Route 425 2533 Wilson-Cambria Road in front of the old cobblestone house known as the Morgan House.</li></ul>	<b>6. Wright Homestead</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on the east side of Daniels Road, South of Braley Rd.</li></ul>
<b>7. 1824 Log Cabin</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is up next to the cabin in front of 4787 Chestnut Road east of North Road</li></ul>	<b>8. Hojack Park</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is at 645 Lake Street on the grounds of the Wilson Historical Society south of the Wilson Station</li></ul>
<b>9. 1836 Pease Homestead</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on the east side of 4455 Wilson Burt Road just east of Maple Road in front of the large brick home of the Pease family.</li></ul>	<b>10. Randall Road Cemetery</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on the west side of Randall Road north of the New Road.</li></ul>
<b>11. Site of First Schoolhouse In Wilson</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is just south of the main entry of the Wilson House Restaurant at the intersection of Young Street and Lake Street.</li></ul>	<b>12. Site of Kruse Brick Kiln</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on the east side of Beebe Road, south of Wilson-Burt Road</li></ul>
<b>13. Clinton Pettit House</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is located at 2471 Maple Road, south of Wilson-Burt Road.</li></ul>	<b>14. Billy Sherman</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on a large stone in front of 4259 Wilson-Burt Road</li></ul>
<b>15. Reuben Wilson's House</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is on the north side of Young Street just south of Bay Street.</li></ul>	<b>16. Randall Road Schoolhouse District #8</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is in front of the schoolhouse which was moved to the grounds of the Wilson Historical Society, 645 Lake Street.</li></ul>
<b>17. Iron Fireman</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is attached to the east wall of the Wilson Fire Co. on 250 Young Street.</li></ul>	<b>18. Michael Witkop Memorial</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Marker is attached to a large stone located at the Greenwood Veterans' Memorial Park.</li></ul>
